Wembury Parish (which includes Down Thomas and Heybrook Bay) has been twinned with Loc-Maria Plouzane since 1981.

Loc-Maris Plouzane is a village situated in a similar location to Wembury in that it is on the coast with beaches and low cliffs. The former being the same distance from the French naval port of Brest as Wembury is from our naval city of Plymouth. They both have many clubs and societies and are close to restaurants, bars and other meeting places.

Our French friends are easily reached by Brittany Ferries from Plymouth and, as we stay with families, transport is arranged from ferry port to homes. The annual visits alternate in the spring of each year and include outings to interesting places, dining out and meals with hosts and their friends. Many Anglo/French friendships are forged with host families, which leads to visits outside the annual trips – the English and French making their own arrangements to visit at other times.

Both villages are encouraging families, with children of secondary school age, to join in our reciprocal exchanges.
