All the recent path and step repairs have been completed at Wembury beach and we are pleased with the enhanced access along this section of the South West coast path. The widening of the path and bridge will make this area more accessible for pushchairs and later this year we hope to improve the meadow path making the back of the beach accessible to wheelchairs.
